what is it?

The goal of this project is to identify best practices, gaps, and barriers, to accessible housing in Indigenous communities in Canada.

This project centers the lived experiences of First Nations, Inuit, and Métis Peoples with disabilities, to examine the current state of accessible housing in participating communities. With the guidance and insight of community members and leaders, we aim to create recommendations, that we hope will be adopted and acted on, to create more inclusive communities across the country.
